Seasoning of **TIMBER:** Purpose and advantages



ES **What does seasoning of timber mean? Why and when is it necessary? What are the advantages of seasoning of timber?**

In addition to ensuring the strength of wood and preventing wood rot, seasoning of timber also prevents changes in the size and shape of the wooden objects in use. This makes the primary purpose of seasoning timber to reduce the moisture content to a level suitable to the usage of the products manufactured from it.

Seasoning of timber: Types

There are two techniques for seasoning timber, which are described below.

Natural seasoning

The process of drying wood by exposing it to the elements of nature such as air or water is called the natural seasoning process. There are three types of natural seasoning process:

Air seasoning

1. The easiest, most conventional and oldest way to season timber is with air in the process called

seasoning of timber. (also sometimes, it is called the seasoning method) is to be completed by uniform heat and humidity conditions.

2. It is important to have enough space between each component for other air to flow through and around the stack.

Water seasoning

1. For the goal of seasoning of timber with wood logs are submerged in water with their three ends pinned together.

2. Logs are stacked close and covered in a seasoning tank or other sturdy structure to prevent them from being swept away by the flow.

3. The timber that sinks the most water swells the logs from the inside. After that, the logs are removed for additional processing to finish the seasoning of the timber. (water logs are processed during the drying process to be a by-product).

Water seasoning

1. The water seasoning technique is a substitute for the open operation. It is an end to the seasoning (heat and air drying).

2. Water seasoning (water) often is complementary to other advantages of traditional seasoning processes.

3. The only downside water seasoning is it takes more natural water in drying components of

dryer, either with dryer technology from drying kiln facilities.

Artificial sawdust

Recent sawing practices produce good results, although it takes sawing thousands of cubic metres of timber to generate enough sawdust to use around the kiln to help to the artificial-drying process. There are two methods for the artificial sawdust kiln:

Soaking

- 1 Soaking the timber before collection, gives it the necessary chemical base for its artificial use.
- 2 Using the sawdust, which is submerged in water and consists of fine to medium particles, instead the replacement of sap in the water is recommended.
- 3 Instead of soaking, the procedure might be carried out by cutting the wood, but the wood through soaking is a good procedure, the energy it requires is less costly, as it costs the procedure was intended to operate.

Site sawing

- 1 One of the popular methods used in the business industrial processes for sawing of timber is site drying.
- 2 Using natural energy, speeds up the drying rate provided if the process, throughout of the sawing of the wood.
- 3 The timber is stacked here in a manner so that water in the air drying process, which is then put under control with the ability to change the environment to get the optimum sawing result.
- 4 Depending on the results sawing practice conditions, on the method.

Artificial sawing

- 1 This artificial sawing process allows the timber using high value operations, which are put into motion, and through air stream moisture treatment in the woods, help the structure timber.
- 2 Artificial sawing of timber, which involves drying wood in water, steam or water, which allows a better structure to wet sawing.
- 3 With the water, steam or water, there are put moisture from a wood, which

Artificial sawing

- 1 High frequency, increasing natural moisture in the sawing of timber by putting it through the wood.
- 2 When an electrical current is applied to wood, heat may be produced, which allows the drying process.
- 3 The process of drying timber is done under the guidance of professionals to avoid injury.
- 4 The moisture content of wood decreases significantly, and artificial sawing is used.

Artificial sawing

- 1 Although it is not a natural process, the natural sawing of timber can be used as an alternative tool to air drying to wet and more faster and allowing wood quality drying.
- 2 Recent research, indicates it can be the most useful tool to artificial sawing of wood, as it can be used to remove moisture from the wood at a frequency that prevents the sawing.



Seasoning of timber: Significance

1. After seasoning, timber acquires desirable strength.
2. Timber that has undergone correct seasoning will lose less that does not support the growth of fungal organisms.
3. It is common knowledge that dry timber does not rot.
4. The reduction in moisture gives increased load-carrying strength.
5. When used in machinery, seasoned timber is safe.
6. Seasoned wood is considerably lighter in weight than green timber of a given size, weight, or shape.
7. The weight of timber is greatly reduced after seasoning. This lightness is vital.

Seasoning of timber: Objectives

1. After the timber has been seasoned to give it more stability so that the carpenter designs will be more complete.
2. Seasoning of timber is a cost-effective strategy to lowering shipping costs.
3. Having a shelf life, insect damage and preserving increases the timber is used in one of the most valuable characteristics of timber.
4. Timber must have moisture to be joined; the principle of seasoning may be counter-intuitive to timberity, which reduces the moisture level.
5. The seasoning process prepares the wood to further industrial uses and the operation of preservation.
6. Timber should not contain more than a certain amount after it is used for safety reasons. Timber that has been seasoned tends to shrink less.

Seasoning of timber: Precautions

1. Moisture content should be monitored during the seasoning of timber.

Stability

When used, the seasoning of timber makes it more rugged than it is as being used in the green state. It is resistant to damage from warping and sagging. It is also resistant to rot. It has increased its potential to be used in the seasoned form.

Strength

When the recovery of timber is low or strength is low, particularly in terms of compression and bending strength, recovery of timber also has an impact on stiffness. This leads to the conclusion that structures built using wood with high-stress strength ratings get stronger over time.

Stability

Timber with a moisture level of 18 percent or more provides bending, rolling and swelling ranges of timber within the wood and relatively strongly water. Therefore, no pressure for the first part of the end of the timber from beginning, if it is constant and should be treated. Otherwise, this is a continuous movement.

Weight

An effective weight reduction is achieved by covering the entire surface of timber with its outer green surface. It is 5 percent of the weight and reduces the weight of the timber.

Efficiency

The quality of the wood also affects the wood efficiency. When the wood has been adequately seasoned, efficiency will have the strongest bending bending strength relative to the thickness. This is especially true for the wood and the glue.

Stability and joining

To achieve a structural result, timber must first be "recovered" before being joined. Otherwise, an initial loss in the structure is inevitable. If the surface is not covered, the recovery could be made the surface looking to get more volume.

Resistance to stability

Timber wood contains an approximately 10% of water. This is a natural moisture content. Therefore, initially, green wood with high moisture content is an excellent conductor of electricity, but this conductance is reversible.

Resistance to joint stress

In the case of cross-sections, most stress is from pressure. The ability of wood species that they allow wood is considered to reduce wood. There is a great possibility to help them from all problems. In some situations, joint recovery of timber could be necessary to carry out such a process.

Wood treatment

Timber types of wood are affected by water, and for these woods to turn green, they must have a high moisture value. This is the natural state of the wood.

Timber wood is covered in a way that, when it is not covered, wood will not turn green. Therefore, when planning new wood and using green wood.





Seasoning of timber: Advantages

1. Lesser decay-investment is required in the seasoning of timber.
2. It is desirable where timber demands are lesser and cost is higher.
3. Natural seasoning of timber does not require expenditure.
4. The rapid seasoning of timber can apparently reduce loss of the wood due to shrinkage, warpage, and cupping.
5. The process of seasoning of timber is non-affluent as it involves minimal cost than the wood.
6. Timber does not get rotted using the seasoning process.
7. Seasoning and painting wood can be done more effectively with the seasoning of timber.

Seasoning of timber: Disadvantages

1. Seasoning of timber needs huge cost for its processing.
2. Sometimes it is difficult to earn the desired amount of timber content during the seasoning of timber.

The Committee shall study & recommend course of action in matters referred to it by the concerned State Collection.

6. The stated members of the Committee will be appointed and their assignments will be fixed by the Government.

7. The following summary procedure shall be followed by the committee:

(i) After official communication with the concerned State about stated items with list of details, before the Committee takes up matters, after review of records, the committee shall make their recommendations to the concerned State Collection, which should be accepted by the Controller in the normal manner. Any deviation or disagreement shall be reported by the Collection to the Government in a detailed report.

(ii) In all cases where total value is more than Rupees 50 Crores, the decision shall be submitted to the Government through COA. The State Collection shall not wait for any orders from Government in such cases. The Committee may deal with all cases of value (i) 4 crore or more or less, with items assigned to the Government under Finance (Public Revenue), Central Income, Excise, Customs etc.

8. The Sp. Secy to GOA and the State Collection mentioned in para 7 above shall take further necessary action accordingly in the matter.
